CLASSROOM SUPPLIES

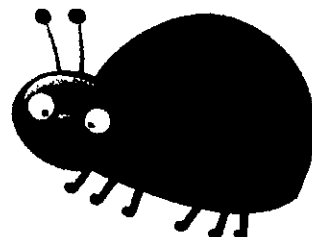
- 4 boxes of 16 count crayons
- 1 box of magic markers
- 4 4oz. bottles of glue
- 4 SOLID colored PLASTIC (MAY NOT BE PAPER) folders with pockets and fasteners in middle
- 2 boxes of dry erase markers
- 1 pencil BAG with zipper (may not be a box!!)
- 1 standard sized backpack (that will fit the folders listed above)
- 1 pack of small paper plates (appetizer size)
- 1 box GALLON size zip-lock freezer bags

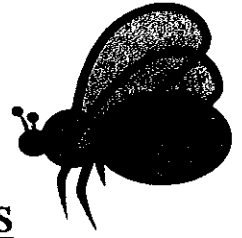
PERSONAL HYGIENE SUPPLIES

- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 1 package of wet wipes (antibacterial if possible)
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 1 change of clothes (shirt, pants/shorts, underwear, socks) in a zip-lock bag labeled with your child's name.

Please DO NOT put your child's name on the above items. Supplies will be handed out as needed. These supplies should last us the entire year, however from time to time I may need to ask for your help in purchasing craft items as the need arises. I ask that you DO NOT send trapper keepers, or pencil boxes...we don't have the storage for them.

You DO need to put your child's name on their backpack, pencil bag, and emergency clothes bag. If we choose to nap during the school year, I will send an informational note regarding the necessities in your "Welcome to Kindergarten" letter.





Ms. Brown's Kindergarten Class Supplies

4 boxes of 8 or 10 count crayons (regular size not the fat ones)

3 4oz. Elmer's glue

2 Packages of construction paper (multi-color pack)

2 Solid colored folders (without brads)

***blue, red, yellow, and green preferred**

2 Solid colored sturdy PLASTIC folders (needs to have pockets and 3 brads to hold papers)

2 Packages of wet wipes

1 Sturdy pencil BAG with a zipper (no boxes please)

1 Pack of dry erase markers

***Boys- 1 Box of zip-lock freezer bags (quart size with a zipper) and 1 box of Kleenex**

***Girls- 1 package of paper plates and 1 roll of paper towels**

Please DO NOT put your child's name on any of the above items except their pencil bag. Supplies will be handed out as needed. These supplies should last us the entire year, however from time to time I may need to ask for your help purchasing craft items, as they are needed (please see the Wish List if you are able to donate some items that are needed). I ask that you do not send trapper keepers/pencil boxes. I have storage for each child.

Your child will also need a regular sized backpack to carry things to and from school. Please make sure their name is on their backpack as others may look alike or be exactly the same. Keep this in mind when sending them with jackets, hats, gloves, and/or scarves.

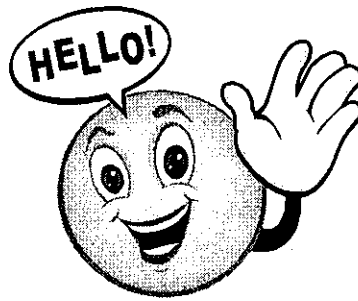
